

## Team B Grade Summer Work

**Math Fluency:** 10-15 minutes (2-3 times a week). Please focus on quick recall of addition, subtraction, and multiplication/division facts.

**Math & Logic:** Use as many opportunities as you can to practice money and telling time skills. Board games are a fantastic way to practice math and strategy without feeling like homework, games like: Monopoly, Yahtzee, Sleeping Queens, or Rack-O (find instructions through Google)

### **L.A.:**

#### 3rd grade:

**Reading:** 15-20 minutes daily (independently or to someone). Let them pick their own books, a mix of graphic novels, chapter books, and educational magazines.

**Writing:** 1-2 paragraphs a week. This can be a casual summer journal, a creative story, or writing letters to friends or family.

**Other ideas:** Sign up for the Holden Joy Summer Reading Program at the Gale Free Library. Libraries are a great way to earn prizes for reading.

4th grade: Choose an Andrew Clements novel and illustrate your favorite scene from it.

Be prepared to talk about it.

5th grade: Read *Bridge to Terabithia* by Katherine Paterson and illustrate your favorite scene from it. Then write a paragraph (5-7 sentences) to summarize the scene.

Be prepared to talk about the book.

**Nature & Exploration:** Mass Audubon Wachusett Meadow Wildlife Sanctuary in near Princeton MA, for hands-on outdoor learning and nature journaling.
